

Terms and conditions

1. Drivers should not be suffering from any condition that would affect their ability to safely use a buggy (Buggy is an invalid carriage, class2, modified).
2. Drivers should not suffer from any visual impairment which would make their use of a buggy unsafe in a public area.
3. Scoot-a-long scooters must be driven with due care and attention, and manoeuvred at appropriate speeds.
4. Consideration must be given to all users.
5. No passenger of any age may be carried on scooter
6. No articles of any kind must not be placed on the handle bars of the scooter.
7. The scooter is loaned out for the sole use of a named person
8. The return journey must commence by the time 4 bars light up Red (50% of BATTERY USED) on the battery indicator. (Spare batteries will be carried by organisers)
9. If the scooter is involved in an accident, whether or not there is damage or injury, it must be reported to scoot-a-long representative as soon as possible.
10. The scooter rider will be liable for any damage or loss that occurs as a result of their negligence or misconduct, and for any resulting repair costs.
11. If following a period of instruction and training an individual is considered unsafe to use a buggy in a public place they will not be permitted to do so.
12. Loan is dependant upon availability of scooters and staff.
13. In the case of adverse conditions Scoot-a-long reserve the right to restrict the provision of their services, or in some circumstances cancel/postpone the outing
